**WHEN:** Saturday, February 27, 2010

**WHERE:** Nardin Park United Methodist Church, 29887 Eleven Mile Rd., Farmington Hills

**PURPOSE:** To recognize individual performance and talent and to aid the student's musical growth.

### **REQUIREMENTS:**

#### **ELIGIBILITY:**

Students in Grades 7-12 who fulfill at least one of the following requirements:

1. Attend Farmington/Farmington Hills public or private schools.
2. Children of Farmington/Farmington Hills residents whose primary residence is in Farmington/Farmington Hills regardless of school attended.
3. Children of Farmington Musicale members.

Applicants will compete in the following divisions:

#### **PERFORMANCE:**

1. Piano and Instrumental 3-6 minutes.
2. Vocal - 2 songs, not to exceed 8 minutes. One must be in a foreign language; the other may be from an opera, oratorio, or Broadway musical.
3. Memorization is optional.

#### **COMPETITION: READ CAREFULLY, ALL ARE REQUIRED**

1. Accompanist required if an accompaniment was originally written, (responsibility of student).
2. Bring one Original score of your music with numbered measures for the judge.
3. Each measure must be numbered.
4. **NO** video or tape recordings permitted.
5. No one is allowed in the performance room except the contestant, accompanist, judges and award officials.
6. A First Place winner may not compete in the same division the following year.

Cash awards may be given to 1st and 2nd place winners in each category. *The decision of the judge is final, based on the performance of that day.* In addition, the Strey-McCallum Memorial Piano Award will be given to the student who is deemed by the judge as the "most outstanding pianist" regardless of grade category. The first place winners will perform their winning composition in recital at Antioch Lutheran Church, Farmington and 13 Mile Rds., on **Sunday March 14, 2010 at 3:00 p.m.** All awards will be presented at this time. Winners must be present at the recital to receive awards. Award checks must be banked or cashed within 30 days.

#### **Application must be postmarked on or before the deadline of February 12, 2010.**
