Our club's purpose shall be to develop the musical talent of its members, foster musical talents of young people, encourage high musical standards and stimulate musical interest in the community. In addition to performers we welcome "listeners".

Our club business meetings/programs are held about 8 times a year, usually on the first Wednesday of the month, September through June, excluding January. The Annual Business Meeting is held in June.

We have a Yearbook for each member that is distributed at our first meeting in September. Also included is a listing of our Performing Members (an audition may be required).

The Chorus, at present, rehearses from September through December providing music for our December program. They occasionally perform at the State Convention on for other programs during the year.

Members serve on one Hostess Committee each year. Any member who cannot serve as listed in the Year Book shall be responsible for trading the assignment with another member. It is necessary to notify the Hostess as well as the Social Committee Chairman of the change.

If a personal situation prevents a member from serving on a committee, a donation toward expenses may be sent to the hostess for the appointed month.

We also have an Awards for Musical Excellence Committee that handles arrangements for the competition and the Winners Recital. Our main Source of funding is through the results of our Fundraising Committee. A program to raise money is usually held in the spring and all members are encourages to support this effort by purchasing a ticket and by their attendance.
